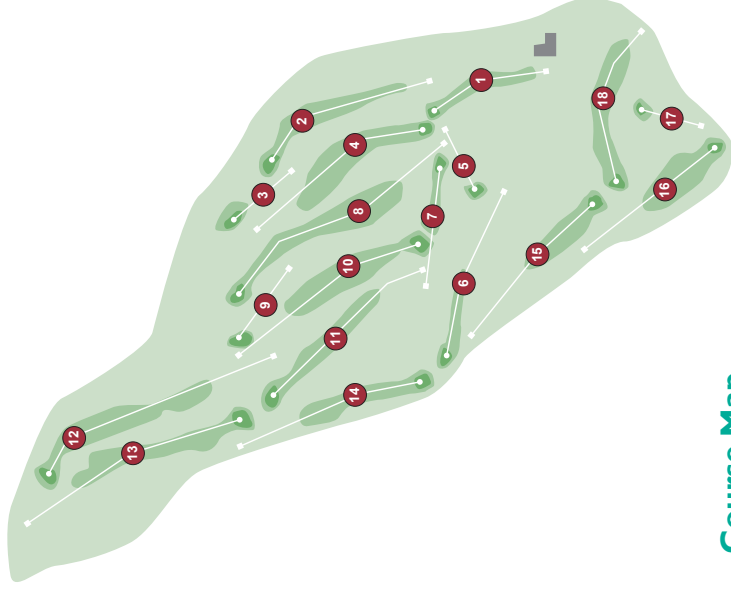

KENDAL GOLF CLUB LOCAL RULES

- Through the green, a ball that is embedded in its own pitch mark in the ground may be lifted, without penalty, cleaned and dropped as near as possible to where it lay but not nearer the hole. The ball when dropped must first strike a part of the course through the green.
- All shelters, huts and posts are immovable obstructions from which relief may be gained under rule 24.2.
When a ball lies in or on the obstruction, or when the obstruction interferes with the player's stance or the area of his intended swing, otherwise intervention on the line of play is not, of itself, interference under this rule.
All walls, fences, stiles are integral parts of the course, where the ball must be played as it lies or deemed unplayable, see rule 28.
Note if the fence guarding the 11th tee obstructs a player in playing a shot, relief may be taken, without penalty, by dropping the ball, not nearer the hole, in a line through the point where the ball came to rest and the hole.
- All manmade roads, tracks and paths are obstructions, rule 24, from which relief may be taken without penalty, see rule 24-2b. Ball should be lifted and dropped within one club length of and not nearer the hole, than the nearest point of relief.
- The pond between the 12th and 13th fairways and the ditches on 5th and 16th are water hazards, rule 26.
- The following are **OUT OF BOUNDS**
 - All lands beyond the boundary fence or wall.
 - All woods.
 - 6th and 15th holes to the left of the white posts.
 - 15th hole the cliffs behind the green as defined by white posts.
 - 15th hole the tree plantation to righthand side of fairway.
 - 16th hole the cliffs to the lefthand side of the fairway.
 - when playing, 12th hole to the left of the white posts and line, note the line itself is out of bounds.
 - When playing the 13th hole the balls landing on the out of bounds line between the 12th and 13th holes may be lifted and dropped, without penalty, within one club length not nearer the hole.
 - Visible bedrock on fairways.
'Interference by an abnormal ground condition occurs when a ball lies on or touches the condition'.
Interference by an abnormal ground condition with a player's stance is deemed not to be, of itself, interference under this rule. Relief may be taken, from these areas under rule 25-1.
 - If a staked tree interferes with a player's stance or the area of his/her intended swing, the ball must be lifted, without penalty, and dropped in accordance with the procedure prescribed in rule 24-2b (immovable obstruction).
 - Drainage channels adjacent to 7th, 15th and 17th greens. Full relief maybe taken as per rule 25/1b, abnormal ground conditions.
 - Yardage markers are to the centre of the green. Blue – 200 yards, Yellow and Green posts to side of fairway – 150 yards, Red – 100 yards.
